

Create Polls

Your site comes with a built-in online polling feature. A Manager has the ability to create, maintain and remove polls. If your site has more than one Manager, they all will have access to create and manage polls.

The Manager sets start and end dates for the poll. Voting end dates can come prior to the display end date so that final results can be displayed for visitors without further voting taking place.

To begin using this feature, follow these simple steps:

- **Enter the Manager module**
Click on the **Polls** button to proceed. You will see a list of sections for your site.
- **Select Section/Sub-section**
Click on the **Edit Polls** button to the left of the section or sub-section for which you wish to create a poll. Click the **Add Poll** button to create a new poll.



Type the poll question into the text field labeled **Poll Topic**.

After entering the poll topic, you are ready to add options for visitors to select. Click the **Add Choices** button. Select the **Add Choice** button to add a new choice. Simply type in the choice in the field labeled **Choice Text**. You can also enter a URL in the **Choice URL** field. You can link to Web sites, specific Web pages, or images.



When finished, click the **Add Choice** button to complete the addition of this choice. Repeat these steps as many times as necessary until you are happy with your choices. When you are done adding all your choices, click the **Back to Poll** button.

Set the **Start** and **End Dates** for the poll to display. You will also need to set the **Vote End** date. By default the poll is set to start on the current date, and expire the following day.

You can set the **Vote End** date to fall prior to the **End Date**. This way you can display the final poll results for a period of time, but prevent further voting from taking place.

Finally, select **Yes** or **No** for the **Require Vote to See Results** option. If you select **Yes**, the visitor cannot see the results until they vote. If you select **No**, a small link will appear in the poll allowing visitors to view the current poll results before voting.

Once everything is set up, you need only click the **Add Poll** button at the bottom of the page. You can come back and edit this poll (reword the topic, add/delete/edit choices, and change the dates) at anytime.

NOTE: After the poll expires it will no longer be displayed in the **Polls** menu under that section. The results are not saved for future viewing.
